



USA vs Australia Costs (\$/W)





METRONET AND INFILL TO SHAPE NEW COMMERCIAL HUBS IN PERTH

The McGowan Government's priority to reinvigorate Western Australia's economy and enhance the iveability of our cities and towns is taking shape. Smart planning and collaboration is helping grow our economy - creating jobs

and investor certainty and encouraging vibrant, sustainable communities. The Government's approach to a

compact urban lootprint is to prioritise infill near quality public transport to ensure a mixture of medium and highdensity housing alongside commercial tenancies and vibrant community spaces.

As the density of our suburbs change and more infill is delivered, precinct. and design policies are crucial to providing quality developments that contribute positively to our local areas.

The roll-out of Metropet will play a major role in the creation of new and vibrant precincts. For example, the planning for the Forrestfield and Bernont stations is being revisited by the Metronet team, with the City of Kalamunda and the City of Belmont to create highly functional and bury preciricts in the surrounding areas.

The first stage of Metronet includes up to 18 new stations, which have the potential to become attractive onw areas to live, recreate and do business.

The State Government, with LandCorp, recently called for private sector investment in more than 30 precinct-scale project opportunities capable of eventually generating thousands of jobs for Western Australiam:

The diverse range of high-quality commercial and residential land lots will boost economic growth and create lively new communities to support our growing population. A number of these projects have particular potential to support aged care and integrated services, quality moved-use infill and residential development close to public

transport links. In the city we have a number of new prove an asset for locals, visitors an

developments such as the notel and apartment projects at Elasbeth Quay and construction at Perth City Link. which is focused on completing the King and Lake Street connection. By early 2018, the new connection and the William Street Mail will open. providing opportunities for businesses to prosper

Meanwhile, the Metropolitan Redevelopment Authority (MRA) has signed an agreement for a 250 room Dorsett Hotel and serviced apartments to be built on the two kits adjused. to Perth Arena, with a development application due to be lodged by mid-

2018. To the north, there are major project investments such as the Ocean Reel Marina, which will eventually become a must see destination for Perth and






Urban Density, 1995 (Persons/Ha)






The business-as-usual predicts numbers of people who could use a railway line based on present land use.



The Entrepreneur Rail Model starts by the private sector predicting **how much land can be developed** as the fundamental source of the funding.






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






Volume of Plug-in Electric Vehicles and % Growth 2015-2016


Yearly demand for EV battery power




