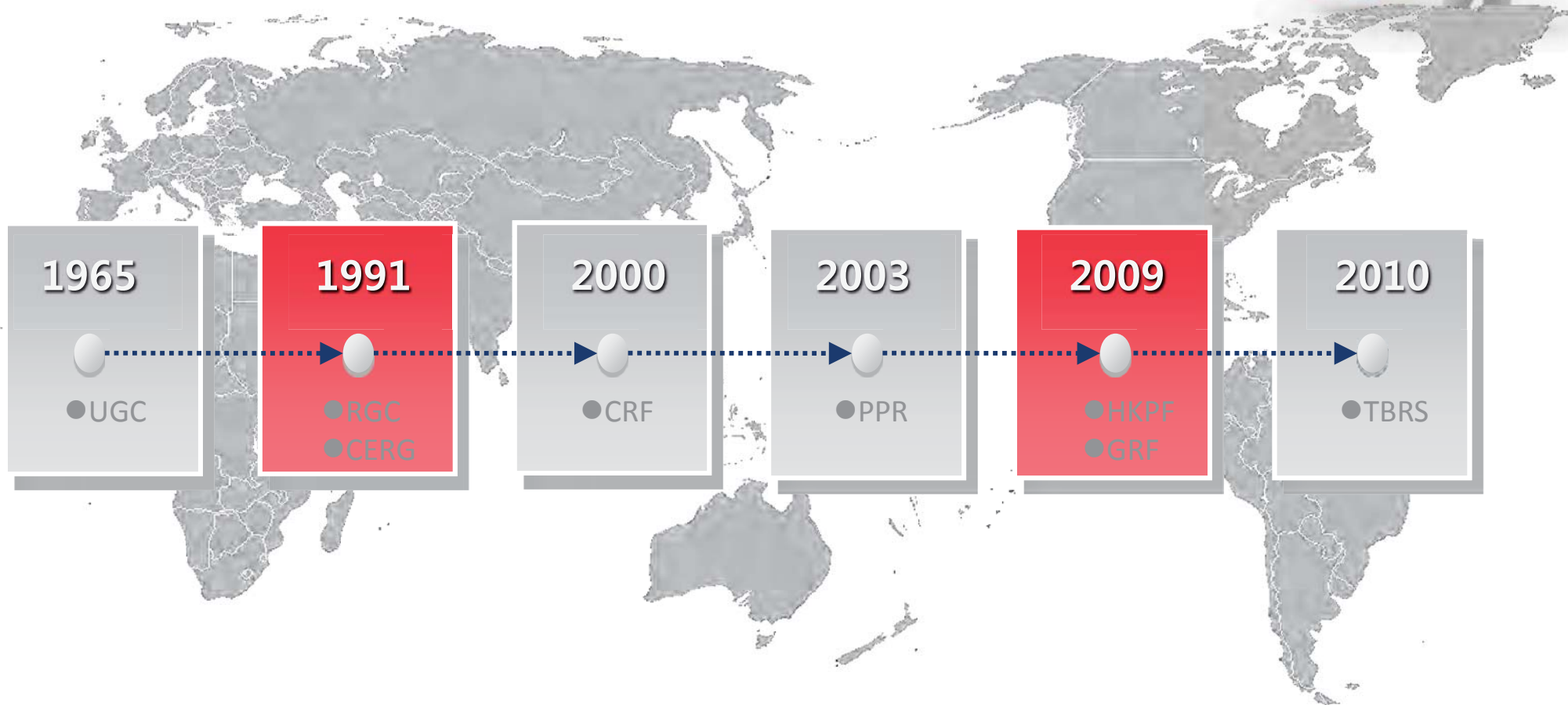

Brief History of Research Funding in Hong Kong

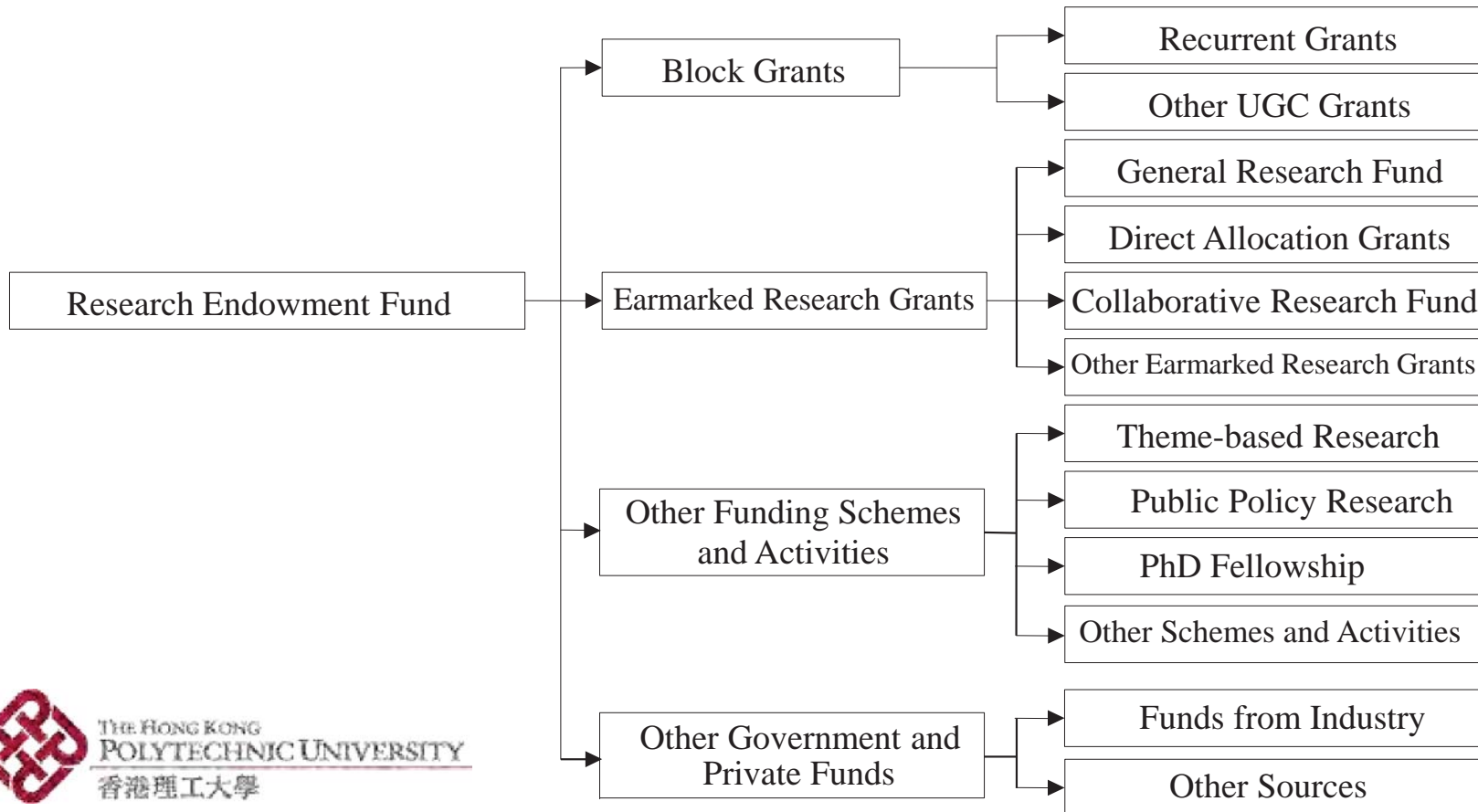


Background

There are two main sources of funding for research in the UGC-funded institutions in Hong Kong :

- UGC and RGC funds via block grants or earmarked/indicated grants; and
- Other Government and private funds.

Background



The University Grants Committee (UGC)

Established in 1965, a non-statutory advisory committee responsible for the development and funding needs of higher education institutions in Hong Kong.

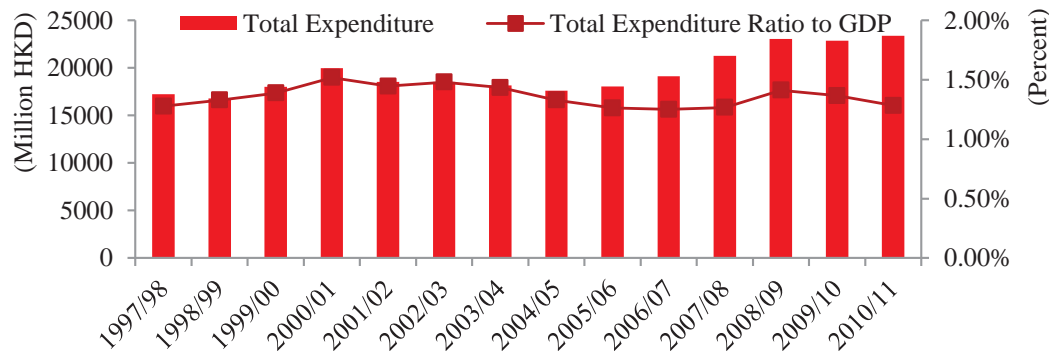
The Research Grants Council (RGC)

To meet the needs of the tertiary institutions in Hong Kong in the field of academic research

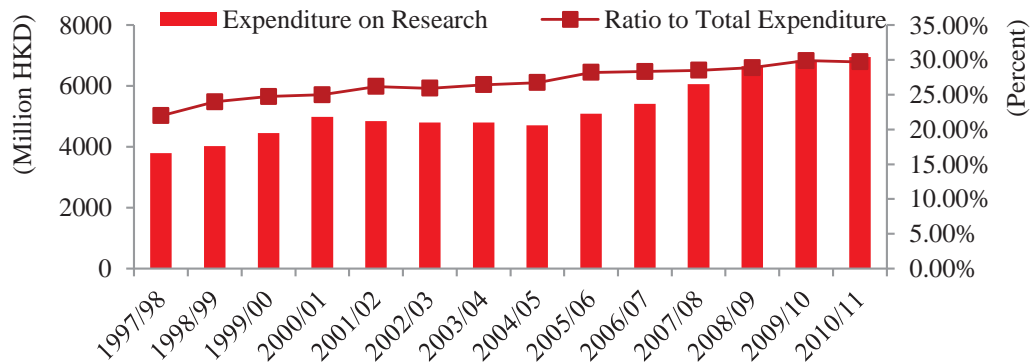

● Expenditure on Research

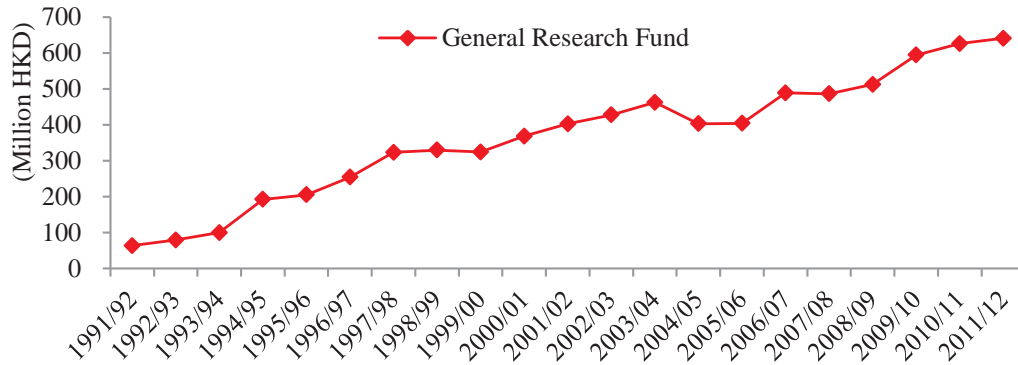

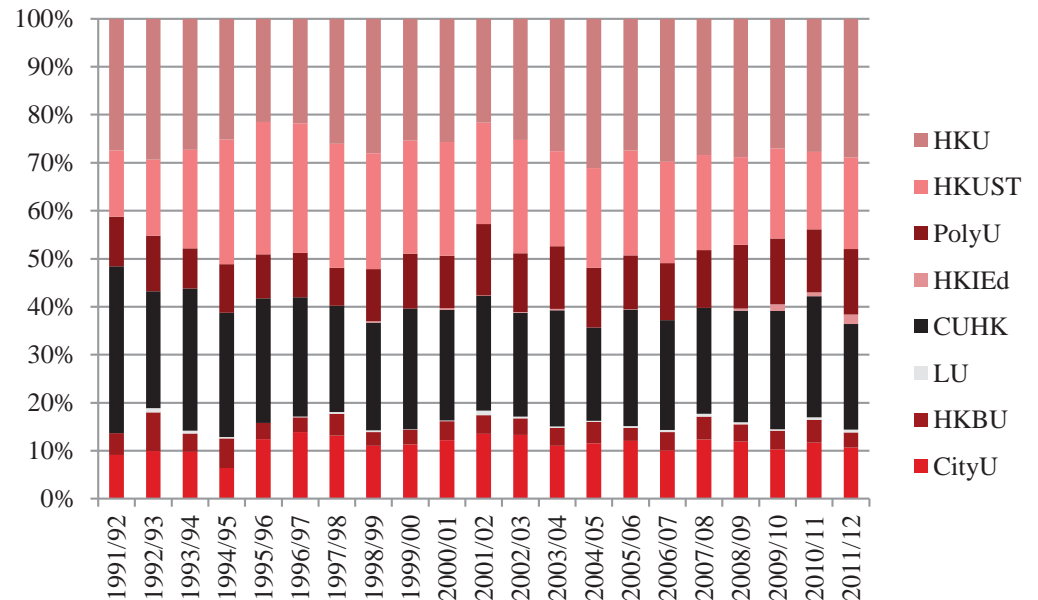


General Research Fund (GRF)

● The Different Proportions for Eight UGC-Funded Institutions

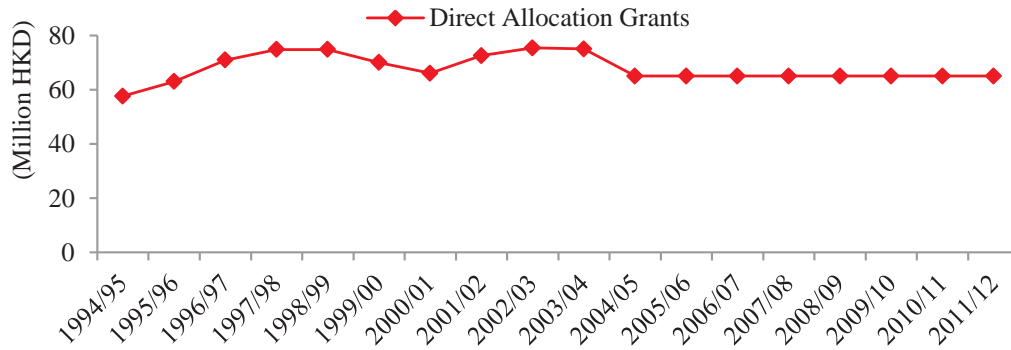

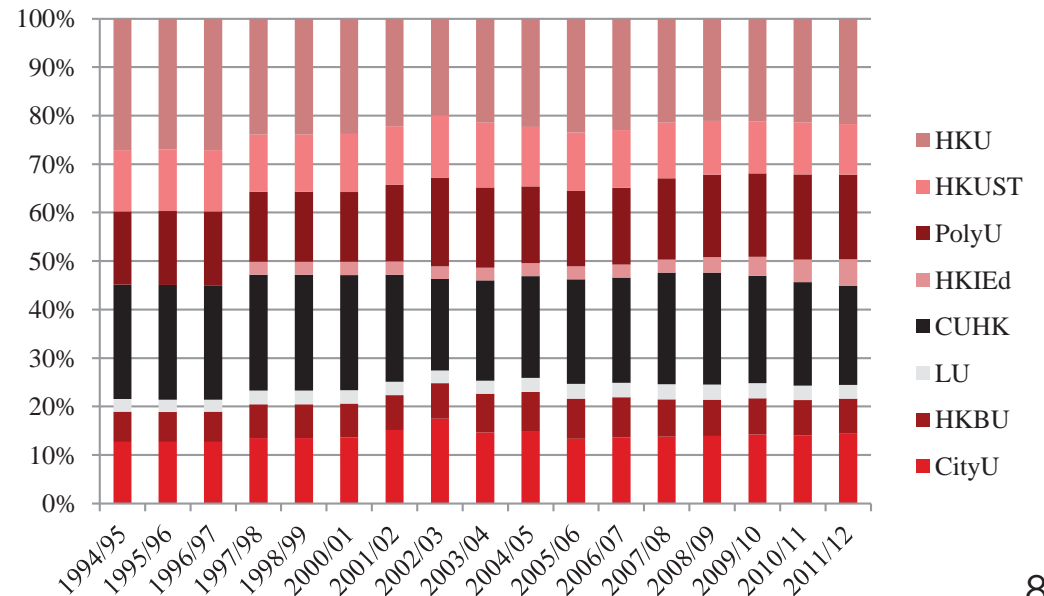


Direct Allocation Grants (DAG)

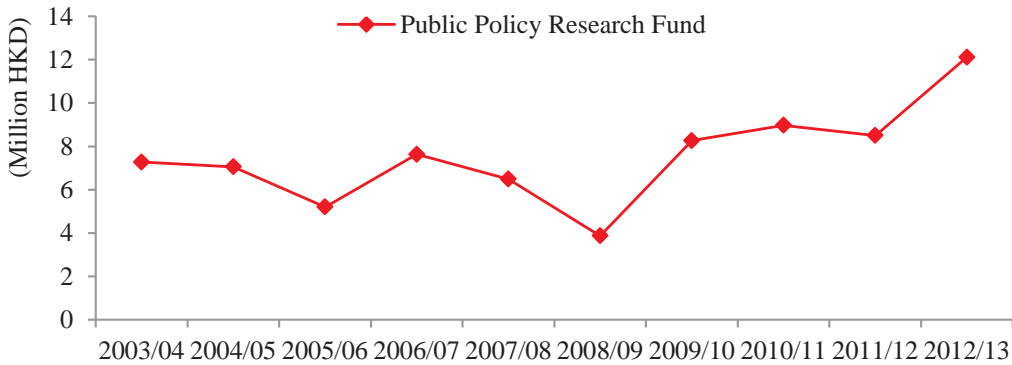

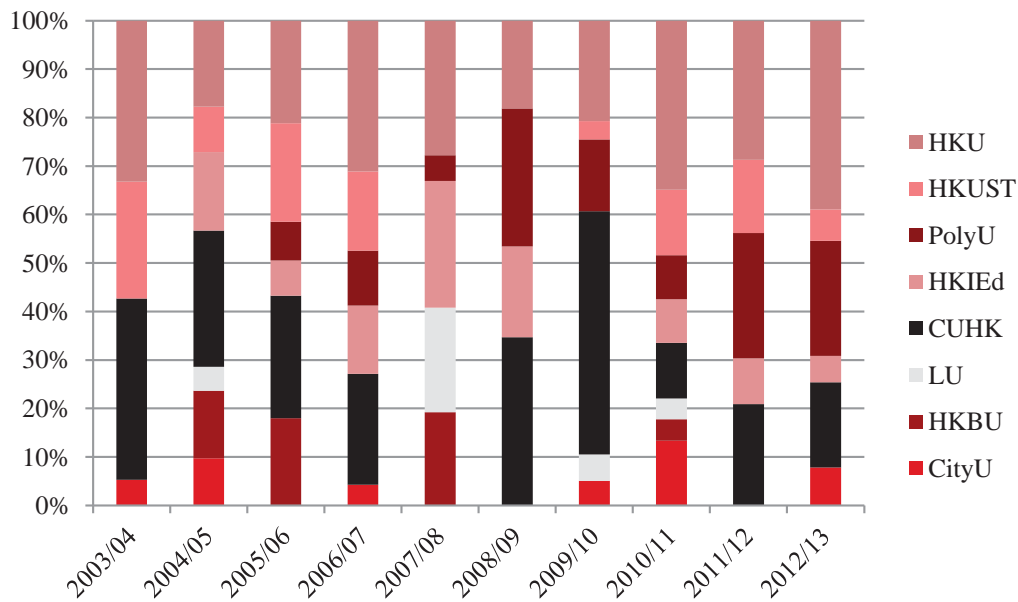


Public Policy Research (PPR)

Public Policy Research from 2003-2012

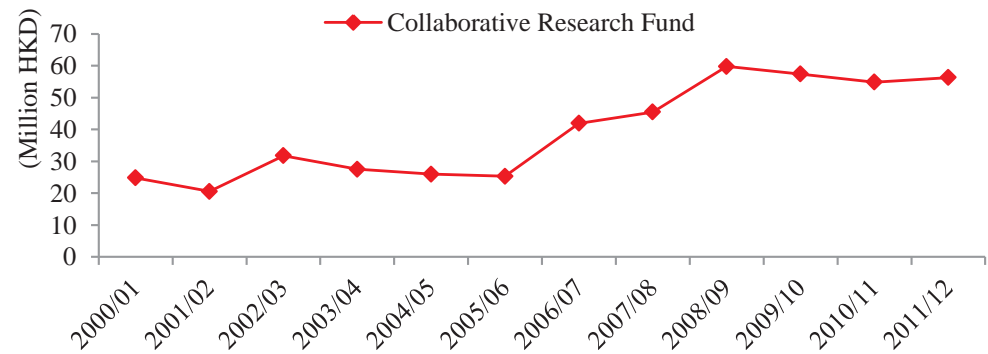

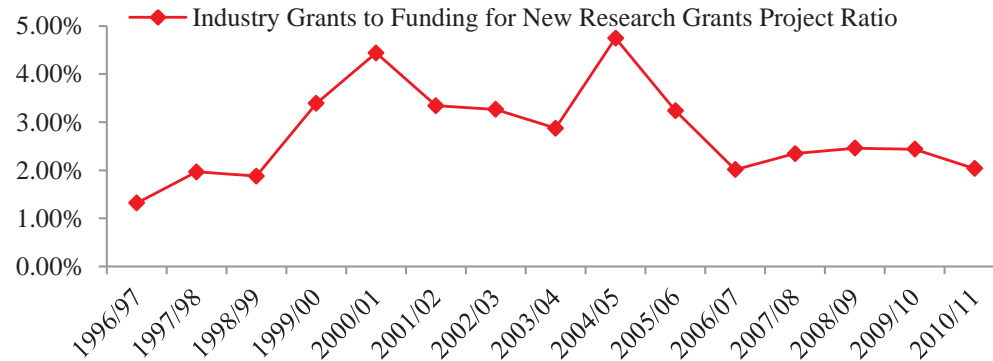
Collaborative Research Fund from 2000-2011



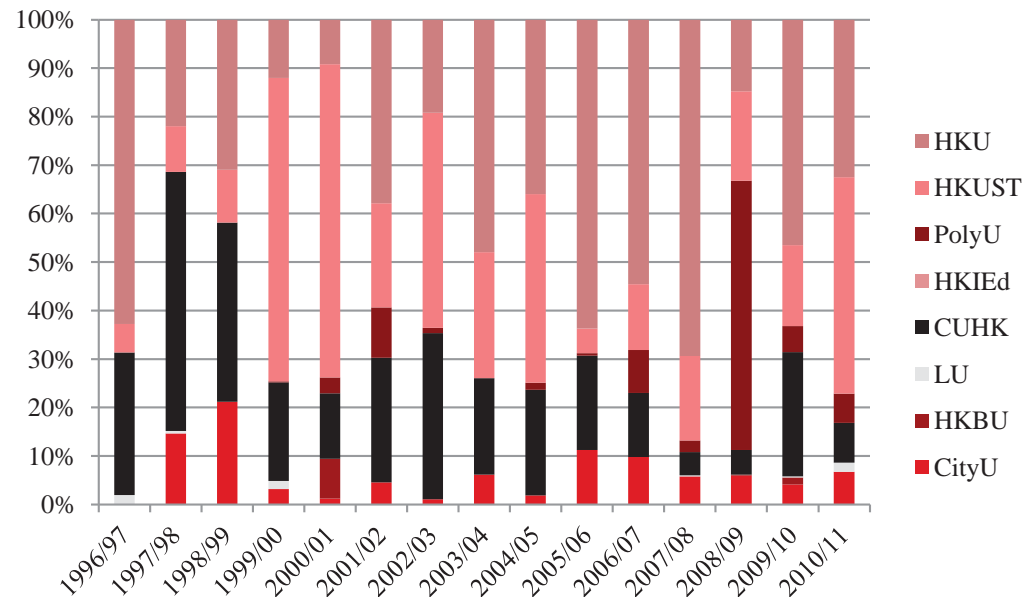

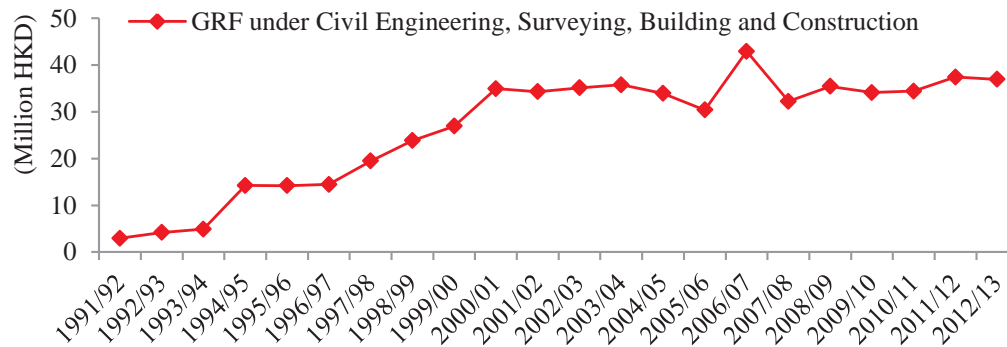


● The Grants Proportions for Eight UGC-Funded Institutions

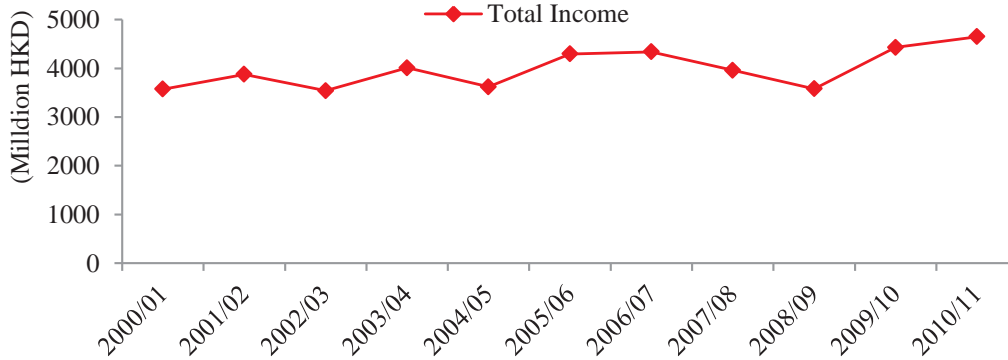

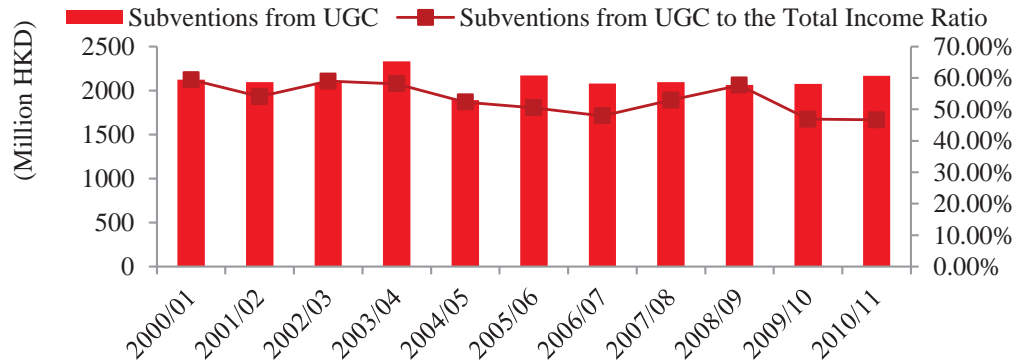

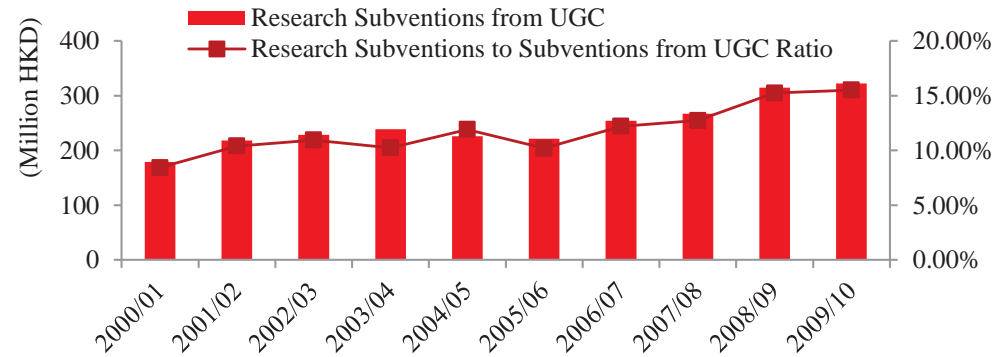
● The Total Income

● Research Subventions



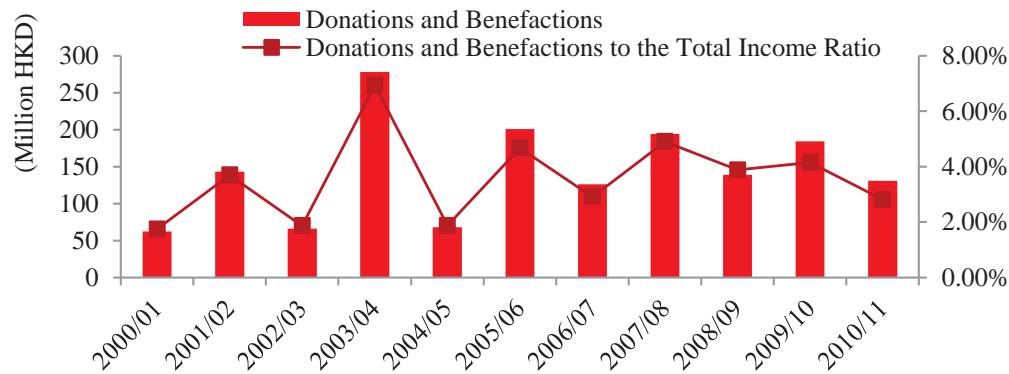
